Clean and honest drinking water,

Time is to perform each prayer on time.

Ghusl (ablution). The conditions of ghusl are to wash the mouth, nose and water all over the body, to wash the hands, to wash the dirty areas, to perform ablutions in an orderly manner, feet, face, neck, ears, hands and elbows, 5 times a day, such as washing before prayer. From the observation of the prevalence of certain diseases in those who regularly pray and those who do not, it is clear that in those who pray: perforation of the rectum, paroproctitis and other purulent diseases are almost non-existent, as well as in them settings bowel movements, hemorrhoids are rare; the biorhythm of defecation is maintained.

In addition, students perform conditional movements 5 times a day: turning their heads left and right, raising their arms, bending, sitting on their knees and so on. As a result, a number of diseases that are common in the elderly, such as osteochondrosis



of the neck and joints, are rare in the elderly who pray. In addition, prayer usually has a positive effect on the nervous system. One stays alert all day.

Fasting has a positive effect on a number of diseases, has a therapeutic effect on obesity, cardiovascular disease, atherosclerosis, gout, etc., relieves stress. As a result, treatment for starvation has become increasingly popular. It is well known that cleanliness is one of the main conditions of health. The Prophet (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said, "Freedom is from faith," meaning that purity is part of the faith and Islam calls people to mass purity. Everything about a person's body, clothing, standing and sitting, etc, should be kept clean. Purification is obligatory before all prayers and washing is the same.

In verses 90-91 of Surat al-Ma'ida, Allah states that alcohol and gambling are forbidden: O you who believe! Alcohol, gambling, idolatry and divination are the work of the devil. Stay away from them until you are saved.

Satan seeks to stir up enmity and hatred among you through alcohol and gambling. And they want to prevent you from the remembrance and prayer of Allah.

Allah says that gambling with vodka is a filthy thing, the work of the devil. Because of these two things, there is a lot of evil and corruption. The dangers of vodka are endless. Vodka makes a person who drinks it unscrupulous. As a result, many families are broken up, often by riots, riots, murders and other crimes. Because of vodka, friends become enemies.

Vodka prevents a person from remembering Allah and praying. Because a drunkard has no mind, how can a fool pray? Prayer depends on the mind. The many negative habits that result from consuming vodka, our young people need to know that Islam was forbidden to Muslims 15 centuries ago in order to protect people from its bad consequences.
