Great work is being done in Uzbekistan to study the period of Babur and the Baburids, to study the literary and scientific heritage, to promote it to our people. The country needs the help of the Bo International Foundation.

The inclusion of the works of Shah and poet Babur in the anthology of Uzbek poetry, high school textbooks, the publication of "Boburnoma" in the 40s, the translation into Russian by Michael Sale and the translation into other languages through this translation; History of Babur's life and work, writing PhD and doctoral dissertations in literature, compiling dictionaries for Babur's works, creating the image of Babur in





literature and art, perpetuating the name of the poet in Uzbekistan date back to the twentieth century.

Sabohat Azimjanova and Aziz Qayumov published three volumes of Babur's works in the 1960s; Porso Shamsiyev and Sodiq Mirzayev published a perfect copy of "Boburnoma" close to the scientific-critical text, Saidbek Khasanov published a large photo study of Bobur's "Detailed" application under the name "Mukhtasar" Semantics of Gazelles The fact that Matullah Otajon's book "Boburnoma travels the world" was a scientific contribution to Babur studies. Zahiruddin Muhammad Babur is recognized by scholars around the world, including in Afghanistan. Afghan experts have done a great deal to study and promote the rich heritage of Zahiruddin Muhammad Babur, in particular the Boburnoma. Dr. Abdulhay Habibi, for example, did some serious research on the Boburnoma.

Abdulhay Habibi, along with French orientalist Louis Bazer, Sabohat Azimjanova of Uzbekistan and Muhibul Hasan of India, also took part in the Boburnoma, published by UNESCO in 1980 to mark the 500th anniversary of Babur's birth. In addition, Dr. Habibi has been instrumental in identifying the Baburi letter. [2]

Anthropology has emerged as a separate field and is developing year by year in many countries of America, Europe and Asia, the number of researchers is expanding, the scope of scientific research is expanding and deepening. American Orientalist and Baburist Professor U. Texon, French Professor B. Gremon, Turkish Dr. B. Yocil, Dr. T. Seyhan, Indian Professor Q. Rayis and other scientists are making significant contributions to this field. Dr. Shafiqa Yorqin translated the Kabul section of the Boburnoma into Dari and published it as a separate book in Afghanistan. Dr. Tanju Sayhan's research on Mubayyin, Dr. Bilil Yojil. Suffice it to mention the edition of Babur's devon prepared by him, the translation of the Baburnama by an Egyptian scholar into Arabic, and so on.

But the contribution of Japanese professor Eiji Mano in Babur studies is particularly significant. This hard-working scholar has been studying Babur's works for 40 years. He was the first to compose a scientific-critical text of the Boburnoma, translate the works into Japanese, compose a corridor to the Boburnoma, and write a major work, Bobur and His Period - a collection of four books. His condor for the Boburnoma (a perfect list of the total number of words in the work in alphabetical order and exact location) is one of the most important scientific achievements in Bobur studies. , is very important in the creation of a perfect explanatory dictionary of the language of his works.
