- 3. Cultivating an ethical attitude to work determines the entire spiritual direction of a person.
- 4. Educating the moral attitude of a person to himself, to his behavior is to teach the student to educate himself in the spirit of conscious discipline.

Man is the greatest gift of nature. He is endowed with such great qualities as intelligence, consciousness, insight, that he polishes and develops his human qualities and leads the world and humanity to perfection[17].

In the process of forming a person as a person, the level of his maturity is determined by the extent to which feelings such as manners, morality, culture, and spirituality are embodied in him. Here we should dwell on the essence of these categories[3].

Etiquette is the ability of every person to control himself in his communication and behavior with another person or group .

Manners are an inner feeling, a skill -turned form of manners.

Morality is a set of standards of behavior approved by the public opinion accepted in society.

Culture is a set of all positive achievements accumulated during the activity of society and citizens living in it.

Spirituality is a complex of all positive, spiritual, intellectual qualities that reflect



the human mind[18].

Observation leads to development of the mind. The mind refines the mind, and the mind becomes a material and spiritual resource. In this way, a person gradually improves and reaches perfection.

Avloni urges people to become people who have good qualities in themselves, who are in the public eye, who strive for good, and who have learned to educate themselves[4].

National methods used by our people in raising children can be summarized into groups as follows:

- 1. Explanation: teaching, habituation, training, etc
- 2. Example: giving advice, apologizing, talking about kindness, setting an example, etc.
- 3. To advise, to instruct: to encourage, to persuade, to request, to beg, to wish, to approve, to say thank you, to pray, to wish for a white road, etc.
- 4. Reproach and Punishment: ban, body, grudge, rebuke, compel, blame, blame, shame, threaten, hate, swear, beat, etc[26].

If you look closely, there is a wholeness to this sequence of national education methods. For example, first it is explained to the child, then it is shown as an example . Our people knew well that this was a last resort[14].

The national methods of our people were implemented through certain means. The following served as a means of education: waiting for a guest, going to a guest, various labor processes, hashars, various gurungs, competitions, various ceremonies and others.

Today, it is necessary to take national traditions and universal human values as the basis for education of students. These, in turn, require the appropriate methods and forms of new education[12].

In modern scientific literature, educational methods are divided into several (4) groups based on their characteristics: methods of forming social consciousness, methods of forming social character in the process of activity; incentive and punishment methods; methods of self-education[27].



- **1. Methods of forming social consciousness:** conversation, story, example, explanation.
- **2. Methods of formation of social behavior:** training, teaching, assignment, pedagogical requirement, habituation.
- **3. Methods of encouragement and punishment:** reassurance, praise, gift giving, commendation, material award, honor board, support, responsibility and gratitude, competition, newspaper and radio e' to encourage such as lon; reprimand, warn, reprimand, shame, etc. However, physical punishment, beating is not possible, but intimidation and intimidation also do not give good results, the student learns to lie because he is afraid, he is a hypocrite. remains[5].
- **4. Self-discipline:** personal commitment, self-control, self-criticism, self-analysis, self-evaluation, etc.

Methods of forming social consciousness **group** includes methods of influencing students' consciousness, feelings and will in order to form scientific outlook, beliefs, spiritual and political ideas[19]. The most used method to shape the minds of students through these methods is **explanation**. The task of explanation is to help educate students to be highly cultured and nationally proud. For example, students can be explained the meaning of the flag, coat of arms, national anthem, and constitutions[13].

Conversation method. The living word of the teacher is the most effective way to form the student's personality in a spiritual and moral way.

on questions and answers . When choosing a topic for an interview, it is necessary to take into account its relevance, interest and the expected result. The conversation can be organized on various topics: moral topics, aesthetic topics, political topics, topics related to education and knowledge, etc. During the conversation, students have the opportunity to think independently and answer.

Story method. Young students are usually interested in listening to stories from life and fiction. He can tell them about moral standards, rules of history, natural resources of our country, wonderful, hardworking people, history, literature, art[28]. Conversations and stories should be conducted on age-appropriate topics and in a language they understand. It is good that the students themselves choose the topic of conversation and story[20].

Sample. It is known that young children imitate adults, try to be like them. That is why, first of all, the teacher himself should be exemplary in every way, and manage his behavior correctly. Otherwise, students may be influenced not only by positive qualities, but also by negative behaviors[9].

lives and activities of advanced people, good examples of the behavior of heroes in works of art, movies, and plays have a strong impact on children's minds[23].

The method of our ancestors is widely used as a national education method. After all, they always encouraged their children to learn from good, wise and great people . For example, our wise people who say, "A bird does what it sees in its nest."

Method of formation of social behavior in students. As we know from psychology, a person develops in his work. Moreover, understanding alone is not enough for the reader. He must observe and follow the moral and legal rules he has mastered and understood. That's why there are ways to form students' behaviors required by society[10].

Exercise. This method is to organize children's activities rationally, purposefully and comprehensively, to accustom them to comply with moral standards and rules of behavior. Habits are formed from childhood and then become stronger. It is necessary and necessary for parents and teachers to monitor the formation of positive habits in children[8].

Exercise involves repeating certain behaviors many times. Practice and habituation is a conscious and positive process for the learner. As a result of the exercise, new skills and knowledge are formed, mental abilities and moral qualities are developed in students. The habit is strengthened by regular practice[21].

Teaching is a practical activity that is organized in a planned and consistent manner for the pupils to perform in order to transform it into a habitual form of social behavior . Teaching is a set of several consistent actions, the teacher can show, explain, observe these actions. There are different types of training in education: training in activities, routine exercises, special exercises[22].

Games are also an important educational tool for young students. Children's folk games have always been a powerful educational tool and method for the formation of behavioral standards in children. For example, aunt-aunt game, waiting for guests, etc

Assignment. Completing the work tasks as a team , students learn to devote their energy to the common work, to feel responsibility for the team. Mental and physical work forms and strengthens the child's character[11].

Demand. Pedagogical demand is one of the most important methods of education. A requirement is to set a task before the student. It can be expressed as a specific task that requires the student to express the criteria of social behavior, to participate in one or another activity .

encouragement and punishment. These methods motivate students, instill confidence in their own strength[7]. As a result of using motivational methods, the child begins



to see that his place is moving forward, he realizes that he respects, that he does not trust, that he is needed by the team, that his teacher is interested. Encouragement is based on the child's confidence, recognition of the strength of positive abilities and qualities that he has. Stimulation lifts the spirits of the student, brings him joy, helps the student to strive to be better[6].
