Tarasevich, M.G.Davletshin, K.Zaripov, S.Rajabova, B.Khojaev and others pay special attention to the importance of pedagogical techniques in the professional training of teachers. In the correspondence of 1586, the following requirements were set for the teachers: "... the teacher of the school, besides being pious, should be prudent, modest, but also wise, courteous, free from alcohol, kind, far from imagination, but at the same time he should strive for good qualities". At the beginning of the 17th century, the well-known founder of world pedagogy, Ya.A. Komensky, the main goal of the teacher: "to be able to demonstrate personal high morals, love for people, knowledge, hard work and other qualities, which encourages students to be an example, to carry out educational work on the basis of humanitarianism to be a mature specialist in his profession", he said.
