What is "Bingo" game in teaching vocabulary in education system?

Students place words or equations on their board. Then they compete against other students in the class as the teacher reads definitions for the words or equations. The first student with five in a row wins a small prize and the game starts over. Vocabulary bingo is a fun and popular activity that gives learners the opportunity to develop reading fluency through increasing sight word recognition and reading speed. Learners play bingo using cards with vocabulary words written on them.

This method is divided into three different steps that the first step is how to organise a game, the second one is how to play it and the third one is another part of the game. **First of all**, you should write some words abouteight or ten on paper or on the blackboard in the clouds or any shapes of frame such as fruits, trees or cartoonanimals. However, it is proper to use shape of clouds like below: After writing some tough words on the list you should put them into clouds. Your handmade must be so impressive with various colours which can attract pupils' focus fast and easy. In addition toyou ought to make a listening track which is for definitions of new and difficult vocabularies



**The next step:** Then, you will show some vocabularies (with intermediate level) in the clouds. As pupils concentrate on learning new words you should explain the meanings of words with the help of definitions in the recording. Vocabularies should be given like that:

Assist

majestic

feeble

defy

efficient

display

appetite

forgive and so on.

For instance: You may give some appropriate definitions of words that given above **Assist**is to do anything that makes something easier for a person. It is to add your efforts to someone else's. Aid has to do with things like healing, bringing someone up, and less of making something easier.

**Majestic** isbeautiful, powerful, or causing great admiration and respect: The majestic Montana scenery will leave you breathless. Synonyms. magnificent.

**Feeble** is weak, feeble, frail, fragile, infirm, decrepit mean not strong enough to endure strain, pressure, or strenuous effort. weak applies to deficiency or inferiority in strength or power of any sort.

**Defy** is verb If you defy someone or something that is trying to make you behave in a particular way, you refuse to obey them and behave in that way.



**Efficient** is achieving maximum productivity with minimum wasted effort or expense.(of a person) working in a well-organized and competent way.

Definitions might be given in this form in the tracks. You may need to repeat the definitions twice. As students listen to the definition, they have a look at their vocabularies. If they have a word matching the definition, they cross it off. The game continues until someone shouts bingo.

And in the final part of the game You should plan to play bingo again. Same steps but with a twist. This time, the students will draw the slips of paper from the clouds and they will be asked to provide the definition. I toy with the definition can assist pupils to be immersed in and to broaden their horizons.



So it is found as very productive method for secondary and primary schools.

Above you may see some shapes which are proper forms to write new terms into them. And if you give students these cards with vivid colours, they can improve their mood and the students can learn better.

And for children who study in primary school you can utilize another type of "Bingo" game . A traditional way to play ESL bingo is to put English vocabulary words on the cards. Students then need to listen for those words as you call them out so they can mark them off. For beginners, you can use pictures on the bingo cards instead of written vocabulary words.
