

ATTITUDE - EFFECTS OF POPULAR POLICY

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Information Policy of Denov District Governor Adviser on Issues

On March 13, 2023, the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev visited the Surkhandarya region in order to get acquainted with the progress of socioeconomic reforms in the regions. While carefully observing the process, we witnessed that the state policy reflects people's wishes and noble dreams and is becoming more and more populist. Taking into account the objections of the people about the quality of the roads in the "Boysun-Denov" direction, the head of state decided to drive a car on the Surkhandarya roads. Similar life examples are clearly visible during visits to other regions.

In fact, in the past, when talking about the industry of the region, many people thought of the Denov oil plant or the Shorchi flour plant. They were also seasonal enterprises, tied to the agricultural sector. He worked for half a year and did not work the rest of the time. The social infrastructure in the province is lagging, the number of unemployment has increased, and many of our oases are forced to go abroad in search of profitable work. The saddest thing is that it was impossible to walk on the roads of the regional center and districts. A worthwhile market could not be found. In 2016, there were only 25,674 enterprises in the region. By 2022, their number will be 46 thousand reached 252. New markets have been established in almost all districts of the province. 1000 kilometers of international roads and 3000 kilometers of domestic roads were repaired. Nevertheless, the roads in the Boysun-Denov direction still do not meet the demand, and there were problems in the supply of clean drinking water, natural gas, and electricity.

In particular, it was announced that in 2023, an additional 5.5 million dollars will be allocated for the establishment of agricultural service centers in Angor, Zharkurgan, Denov, Kyzyriq, Komkurgan districts, 55 billion soums will be allocated for the improvement of water supply in 38 neighborhoods with difficult conditions, and large amounts of funds will be allocated for other specific purposes. Special attention was paid to providing the population with clean water, natural gas, electricity, and creating conditions for farming in their farms. Instructions were given on the development of the system of school, pre-school education, emergency medical care. Especially, the fact that the repair of Boysun-Denov road started on the day after the visit was a reason for the joy of the residents of the region.





-"Each district has determined the measures of socio-economic development of the regions at the expense of existing opportunities and reserves," says Denov district governor Ilhom Abrorov. - In particular, it is planned to implement four large industrial projects with a total value of 841.7 billion soums in Denov district and thereby create more than two thousand permanent jobs. Also, it is planned to build 3 industrial zones on the area of 27.2 hectares and implement 45 industrial projects within them. At the moment, construction works are underway in two industrial zones on an area of 6.2 hectares. 500 citizens got a new job due to the production of household electrical engineering products in the Denov branch of the "Urgut Free Economic Zone" in the "Kozhichakli" neighborhood. A large trade and service complex, which includes 1715 business entities, is being built on an area of 18.3 hectares in the territory of "Nomozgoh" neighborhood. In addition, it is planned to connect 281 hectares of land - 36 fruit and vegetable farms and households to a large cluster. Also, it is planned to establish a cluster specializing in fruit and vegetable cultivation, storage, processing, export and supply of domestic markets on the basis of the "Logistics Center" complex with a total cost of 39.5 billion soums on the 4hectare area on the side of the "M-41" road. The goal is to ensure employment, attract the population to entrepreneurship and further improve their lifestyle.



In fact, such changes and innovations are observed in all districts of the region. This can also be seen in the example of the activity of "Termiz National Carpets" Limited Liability Company, which has the capacity to produce 2.2 million square meters of carpets per year in the Yangabad neighborhood of Termiz district. The enterprise is equipped with modern equipment from Germany, Belgium, and Turkey. 80% of its raw materials are localized, the company exported carpets and carpet products worth 255 thousand dollars to Azerbaijan and Kyrgyzstan in a short period of time. While getting acquainted with the activities of the enterprise, the President paid special attention to the effective use of alternative energy sources, solar panels for external and internal lighting systems.

The exhibition of industrial products produced in Surkhandarya region was inspected. Representatives of building material small industrial zones and Topalang hydroelectric power stations in Termiz, Zharqorgan, Sariosiyo districts gave information about the potential of the complexes and the scope of the works being carried out through video communication. By the way, as part of the modernization of the Topalang hydroelectric power station, its capacity is increasing to 175 megawatts. This allows to produce 467 million kilowatt hours of energy per year. This station and three small and micro hydroelectric power stations produced 350 million kilowatt hours of electricity this year. Plans have been set to launch a large solar power



plant with a capacity of 457 megawatts in Sherabad district, and to install small-capacity solar panels.

In short, it is planned to allocate 465 billion soums in addition to the 1.5 trillion soums provided in the current year's state programs for solving social problems in Surkhandarya. Also, orders were given to attract additional funds in the amount of 328 million dollars for the agricultural sector, drinking water and business projects. Through these, it was aimed to provide 325,000 residents with profitable work and turn Surkhandarya into a region free of poverty and unemployment.



In a peaceful and peaceful country, development can increase, people can live happily and peacefully. Surkhandarya region, bordering Afghanistan, Tajikistan and Turkmenistan, occupies an important place in this regard. The head of state visited the homes of our soldiers who are serving day and night for the protection of our borders and was interested in their way of life. It was emphasized that today, when the information attack is increasing in the world, strengthening the potential of our Armed Forces, ensuring the unity of the people and the army, and educating young people in the spirit of patriotism should form the core of military reforms.

Every bold step taken with unity and stability serves to ensure the development of the country and to raise it step by step. There is no doubt that the populist policy will bear fruit. Our task is to become more cohesive and make a worthy contribution to bringing Uzbekistan to the ranks of developed countries.
