



## CREATING A LANDSCAPE DESIGN USING FLOWER BEDS AND ALLEY WAYS IN LANDSCAPING PARKS

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### Annotation

Creation of landscape designers using flower beds and alley methods in the greening of recreation parks. First of all, it is necessary to evaluate several processes in choosing the right designer. In particular, it is necessary to know the location of this region, its history and mentality. This article aims to clarify these issues.

### Introduction

Flower bed rabatka - rabatka from perennial flowers give the territory a unique charm and delight with a colorful palette of colors. The indisputable advantages of rabatok are continuous flowering throughout the summer, long life, richness of colors and shapes.

A flower bed will look great both on a vast territory and in a garden that is modest in size. It is important only when arranging a discount to follow simple rules.

Flowerbed rabatka do it yourself. When making a discount in a small area, it is advisable to follow a certain style. Tall and strongly growing varieties, such as comfrey or red geranium, are not suitable for such a garden. In addition, you need to understand that a small area will not allow you to plant dozens of various plant varieties. Since the highest quality care will not save the garden from sloppy flower beds for the reason that in crowded plants they lose their natural look and beauty.

When planning a discount and going to the store for seeds, you need to develop a specific plan in advance and strictly adhere to it. Five or six varieties of plants will make it possible to equip a chic discount.







When planning a discount, first of all, you need to decide on the palette of colors in it. The color solution can be either a method of contrasts or a certain tonality. The flower bed of the rabatka is very effective, designed in white and silvery undertones, no less beautiful and decorated in orange and blue. It is advisable to sort all perennial flowers taking into account the characteristics of the soil in the garden, as well as separate flowers that love the bright sun from admirers of shady places. When arranging a rabatka, it is necessary to understand what maximum height the grown plants can





reach. In a tiny garden, the growth of plants collected in a rabatka is crucial. In this case, delphinium, rudbeckia or yarrow will be appropriate as high flowers.

It would be wise to choose plants for flowering periods for rabatka. Bulbous plants such as hyacinths, tulips or daffodils that bloom in early spring are indispensable in the flower bed. At the moment when they are raging with colors, the rest of the flowers are just waking up after a long winter. But during the flowering period of perennial plants, bulbous plants are already sleeping. Thus, the flowering period is doubled, while the flowers do not interfere with each other.

The flower bed is traditionally decorated with plants that create the main structure and background. Usually they are not endowed with luxurious flowers, but they have textured stems or an extraordinary color of the leaves, slightly muffle the excessive variegation. Their best time comes when there are almost no plants in bloom on the discount. Cereals are considered such crops.

Many suitable plants can be taken to decorate a rabatka in a tiny garden.

Delphinium can bloom a second time in the season if shortened to 10 centimeters after flowering is complete. Astilba Arendsia prefers an acidic environment and an abundance of water when growing in the sun. Endress geranium is drought tolerant, easy to care for, ideal for large areas. Crimson gravel is good because it blooms, as a rule, twice a year. When used in a dicentra, it should be borne in mind that the period of its intensive flowering falls in the spring.

Bluebells grow in bushes, adore water and shady places. The hellebore gives preference to highly fertile soil, it is indispensable for arranging rabatok under the crowns of trees, because it loves shade. Monarda is desirable to be placed in the sun, intensively watering. Rudbeckia needs a fertilizer that enhances its flowering. Without yarrow, you will not get an ideal discount; until November, he will color it with his umbrellas. Phloxes are ideal for rabatka, her favorites. With a rational selection of varieties bloom up to six months. These plants love sunlight, regular fertilizing.

The landscape design of any private plot clearly reflects the lifestyle and preferences of its owner. This was the main reason for the emergence of different styles of decorating areas adjacent to the house.

### **Planting and caring for dahlias**

Today there are many styles of landscape design, but the most popular are: country, Provence, Chinese, Japanese garden.

Country style is characterized by the use of natural materials: wood, and, creating, and. Trees and fruit trees are also required.



The word "country" translated from English means "rustic", so this style is very close to the surrounding natural landscape.

It is not necessary to have a large number of elements here, it is enough to harmoniously place a fence woven from a wooden cart, garden pots and wheels.

Provence style. This style is very specific to France and it is characterized by many bright colors with a strong aroma, palmettes planted along the walls and woven furniture.

Provence style is very elegant and beautiful, but you need a lot of money and free time to create it. In addition, this method requires careful and very complex maintenance.

The Chinese style is very popular in Western Europe today, and the explanation for this is very simple. The basis of the Chinese style is the ancient philosophy of Feng Shui teachings. All elements of landscape design are located in the most direct direction, reflecting the well-being of the owner of this site.

About landscape design.

Landscape is the development and implementation of land change and registration measures. There are many solutions for arranging land. This includes the construction and decoration of lawns and flower beds, the organization of lighting and watering, (sculptures, arbors, bridges, swings), the introduction of artificial ponds, etc. It depends on how the landscape design project is professionally designed and implemented, the site will be comfortable and convenient.

The project development process includes several stages. Before starting the work, the designer discusses with the client his preferences and the client's quantity. If it is a very large amount, then the customer can become the owner of a real art of landscape design that will last for a long time.

In the next step, the designer examines the area of the land, photographs it and takes a soil sample for chemical analysis. Based on the inspection and research, a sketch was prepared that included all the components of the project. In some cases, a large-scale paper plan of the future landscape is provided to the client for review at his request.

At the current stage, different styles of landscape design are distinguished: rural, natural, Japanese, Chinese, mixed. The implementation of one or another design decision depends not only on the client's ability to pay, but also on the characteristics of his site. For example, depending on the characteristics of the soil on the site and the purpose of the future artificial water body, the technology for its creation and regulation is being developed. Hilly land is ideal for construction. There are many ways to design it: with or without an alpine waterfall, it can vary in height and area, it



can be made of certain types of stones, and it can be decorated with various plants. On a flat plot, on the contrary, it looks very cool, by the way, you can do it in a few days.

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Shrubs and trees (ordinary and dwarf) are used to create relatively large elements, which include:

- avenues - straight rows of plants along the road;
- fence - a row of closely planted bushes;
- planting a type of candles and a nest - a group of several plants planted in a row;
- borders - framing of separate plots using densely planted bushes of low size;
- tapeworms - individually planted bushes or trees of special valuable species;
- backstage - a continuous row of trees or bushes that limit the long-distance view;
- labyrinths - high obstacles forming a system of complex paths;





- topiary - small-leaved shrubs and trees, the crowns of which have a strange shape due to curly hair.

All these elements are most characteristic for designing a regular look.



Flowers are the brightest element of landscape design. There are certain ways to arrange flowers in flower beds and flower beds, which will allow you to fully reveal their beauty.

- - forming a certain geometric shape along the contour and area, planting flowers;
- arabesque - a flower bed of an unusual, complex shape;
- - border line of flowers;
- monosad - a site where a specific type of flower grows (rose garden, gladularium, ukule, dahlia);
- border - a narrow row of flowers of the same type at the edge of the fence;
- - A border of flowers of different appearance, color and height.

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
